Syd Krochmalny is an artist and writer interested in the avant-garde and experimental art tradition that focuses on the relationship between art, philosophy and civic engagement. His contribution to the global culture lies in the deep and original combination of Contemporary Art and academic achievements. The Center for Artistic Research is a space used as an intersection between artists and thinkers from various parts of the world, focusing on Latin America. This space attracts narrators, poets, musicians, philosophers, architects, designers, filmmakers, historians, psychoanalysts, technologists, theater people and other disciplines of art and knowledge.
